
Statues in the Yungang Grottoes in Datong (left) and the Hanging Monastery near the city.





MAJOR ORDER FROM CHINA

Assembly and logistics planning from one source for automobile factory in Shenyang

For the expansion of their production capacities at the site Shenyang/Dadong in the Northeast Chinese province Liaoning, the BMW Group has entrusted Ingenics AG with major tasks. Ingenics had already taken on a large part of the planning tasks for the first plant of the automobile manufacturer in the region, which began operations in 2003.

Ingenics CEO Oliver Herkommer states that a doubling of the capacities in the existing plant is planned. The volume of the new order is accordingly large. Implementation is to have been completed in approx. two years.

As a general planner, Ingenics is responsible for both assembly and for the logistics systems. "For a technical consulting company, this connection is not everyday and, in our view, is a unique selling point", says Oliver Herkommer, whose team is on site with up to 25 consultants. For Ingenics, Shenyang is the second foothold in China after Shanghai where the company has had a permanent office for years.
